Hello, Mrs. Christin Harrington,

I received a message from Royalty Department of Taylor & Francis (Mrs. Veneta Barefield) at October 29, 2019 that there are a certain number of my books copies from which royalties are not paid. Therefore, I asked to indicate this number of books copies in order to clarify my claims to the Taylor & Francis. This is a very simple question to which the Taylor & Francis should have a very simple answer. And you promised me a very quick answer ("as soon as possible") to this simple question.

Nearly 20 days have passed since then, but I haven't received any answer from you or from any other persons of Taylor & Francis on my very simple question, despite my reminder at November 6, 2019. You did not fulfill your promise, that is, in fact, deceived me.

If I don't get an answer in the coming days, I will treat this incident as another deception from the Taylor & Francis and an addition attempt to hide from the author information about his real royalties.
